Request to Calculate the Enrollment Adjustment Using a Weight of 1.0: BE IT

RESOLVED, to apply to use a weight of 1.0 for the enrollment adjustment to the base tax levy for the FY 2010-2011school year to provide additional tax levy of \$285,025 to hire staff and provide other resources to reduce class sizes that would otherwise exceed those per the Facility Efficiency Standards by at least 10%. Sufficient facility capacity exists for this.

Request for loss of State Aid: Be It Resolved, to apply for an adjustment for loss of State Aid from the prior budget year in the amount of \$983,426.

Request for an adjustment for increase in health care costs: Be It Resolved, to apply for an adjustment for increase in health care costs above the 2009-2010 school year adjusted per DOE guidelines in the amount of \$8,220.

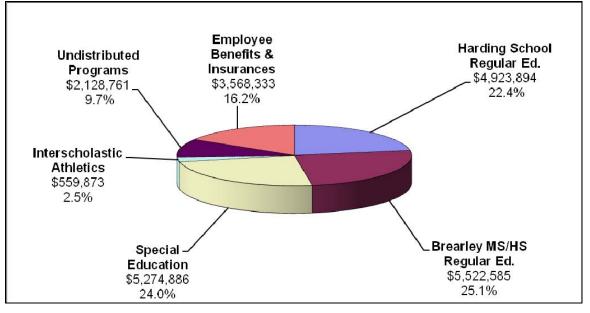

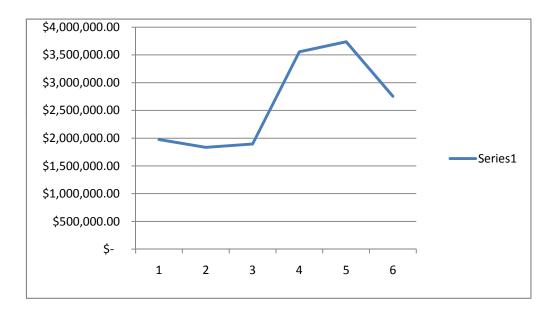

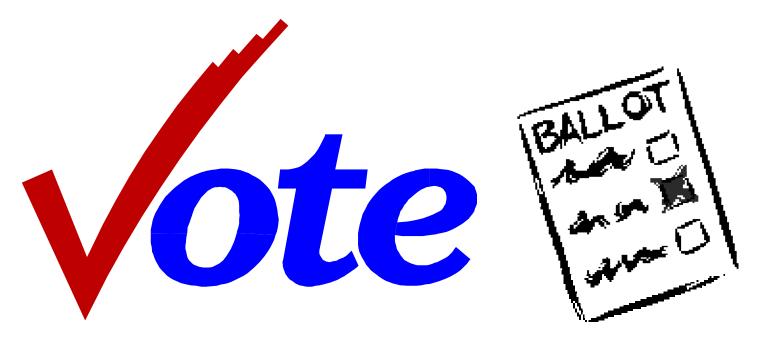
