Summer projects are on schedule. Projects include:

- Several Harding School classrooms were painted while others were patched, walls repaired and paint touched up.
- All 1st grade classrooms' carpets were replaced.
- Brearley auditorium carpet was replaced as well as front stage panels.
- New phone system at Brearley and Harding.
- New clock system at Brearley.
- Upgrade of internet connection from 100 mbps to 1 gbps.

Preparations for the annual audit continue with the auditors scheduled to be in the district the week of August 24th.

The process of retro-active pay for the teachers is now complete once the Board passes resolution #12 this evening. The process was very time consuming, Ms. Duggan should be commended for the quick turnaround time in processing this special payroll.

The Board received several responses to the Request for Proposal for Banking Services. After review, Investors Savings put together a comprehensive package that meets all the district's needs and will save the district in service charges. There is a resolution on the agenda to approve the switch.

Curriculum & Instruction: Nancy Zimmerman, Chairperson.

Gonnella stated that it was his understanding that Mrs. Bound and Dr. Bradley have been in contact with Chairperson Zimmerman regarding starting monthly meetings in September. He stated their focus will be at a higher level than in the past, by explaining what we do to promote student achievement. For example, some topics might include why check-ins and benchmarks are relevant, rather than simply stating the fact that we are doing them. Another topic could be to provide how the

teacher evaluation instrument is being used as an effective way to improve student achievement.
