This meeting is being held in accordance with the schedule of meetings adopted at the organizational meeting held January 6, 2020. Adequate notice of this Regular Meeting of the Kenilworth Board of Education has been provided to the Home News Tribune, The Star-Ledger, and the Local Source. COVID-19 Compliance was updated on December 9, 2020.
