
Kenilworth Interdistrict Choice Program and Scholars' Academy





Kenilworth Interdistrict Choice Program Goal

The goal of the school choice program is to provide greater flexibility to parents and students in the selection of a public school that best meets the needs of the student. It offers parents and students expanded educational opportunities to attend schools outside of the district in which they reside. Parents will have the ability to select a public school best suited to their child's particular interests, abilities and learning needs. Parents will not be charged tuition in order for their children to attend a Choice school.



Kenilworth Interdistrict Choice Program Focus

The Kenilworth Public Schools' Choice program is open to entering grades seven (7) through ten (10) in September of each school year. Our programs at the David Brearley Middle and High School provide all students with a small, personalized, and caring educational environment in a superior educational facility. In addition to our special education and general education programs, we now offer students the option of an Academic Academy (The Kenilworth Scholars' Academy) for those who meet the necessary academic requirements. Each December we have conducted a lottery drawing to determine entrance into our David Brearley Middle and High School as we continue to receive far more applicants than we have available seats. We are a small but outstanding Union County School District assisting each student to reach his/her maximum potential.

Choice Program Eligibility

Applicants must meet the following criteria to be eligible for the Kenilworth Choice Program.

- Students must have been enrolled in a public school during the full year prior to attendance in the Kenilworth School District.
- Students must be eligible for placement in Grades 7 − 10.

The Application Process

Requirements:

- All applications are due by December 1
- Any application that is incomplete will not be accepted
- A completed application consists of:
 - A completed application form
 - Last year's complete transcript
 - Copy of student's first marking period grade for this year (Official grades as of December 1st)
 - 2022-2023 NJSLA Scores



The Application Process

Minimum Requirements for Acceptance into Placement Testing:

- Students must have at least a 90% (A-) final grade in English, Math, Science, and Social Studies on last year's transcript
- This year's first marking period grades (or grades as of December 1st) as well as 2022-2023 NJSLA scores will also be considered



The Application Process

Academy Testing:


- Families will be contacted by December 4th if student qualifies for testing
- Placement testing will consist of three parts:
 - An ELA exam
 - A Math exam
 - A writing sample

Acceptance

- Placement will be determined by factoring grades and scores on placement testing
- Students who do not earn placement but met our minimum requirements may be placed on a waiting list.




