


## Your children's grade-levels:



The District will follow NJDOE and CDC health guidelines. Still, do you intend to send your children to school in the Fall?







- In-person instruction (that follows whatever the "new normal" of school will be.)


Which factors would make you feel more comfortable sending your children to school. Check all that apply.


## What are your primary concerns about the Fall? Check all that apply.

# Has your child(ren) worn a mask or face covering since the pandemic began?






